What is the Regina Multicultural Council?

The Regina Multicultural Council (RMC) is a non-profit organization dedicated to advancing multiculturalism through cooperation and mutual understanding among all cultural and ethnic groups in Regina. The RMC is comprised of 48 local multicultural associations involving over 30,000 individuals. All of our members and the citizens of Regina benefit from the year-round projects of RMC.

What are the RMC scholarships?

Regina Multicultural Council scholarships are intended to support members of the multicultural community of Regina who are pursuing their educational, professional and personal goals. There are three scholarships available: \$500, \$300 and \$200.

Applicant's requirements:

1. Must be a Grade 12 student registered as a full-time student in a recognized post-secondary institution
2. Must be a resident of Regina
3. Must be a member of a Regina Multicultural Council member organization
4. Must submit a completed application and all support materials no later than 4:00 p.m. on **July 15, 2010**

How can I apply for RMC scholarships?

To apply for a RMC scholarship you need to submit:

1. The application forms.
2. A one paragraph biographical sketch.
3. A description of your involvement in your cultural community. List specific examples of your involvement.
4. List and describe any special academic accomplishments attained in high school, as well as extra-curricular student involvement (eg. Student Council, etc)
5. An official transcript.
6. A letter of recommendation from the President or Program Director of your cultural organization.
7. A letter of recommendation from an adult who is not a family member (eg. High School Principal or Guidance Counsellor).

All scholarship applications are due by 4:00 p.m. on **July 15, 2010** at the RMC office located at 2144 Cornwall Street, Regina, SK, S4P 2K7.

How are scholarships awarded?

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit and cultural community involvement.

When will I learn if I receive a scholarship?

Letters of notification are sent to all applicants whether or not they receive a scholarship. Everyone should receive a letter after August 15, 2010. Once you receive your letter, you will have 30 days to notify the RMC as to whether or not you will accept the scholarship. If a student decides not to accept a scholarship, it will be awarded to an alternate student or will be reopened for applications.

How are scholarships paid?

RMC scholarships will be applied to your student account in September 2010. Scholarship funds must be used for tuition or books.
